 Division 22 Standards Assurances 2017-2018  
 Approved by Dayton School Board: January 9, 2018

By February 1<sup>st</sup> of each year, school district superintendents are required to report to their local school board the district’s standing with respect to all Standards for Public Elementary and Secondary Schools as set forth in Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs) 581-002-2305, or what is more commonly called “Division 22”. District are also required to post the report to their websites by February 1, 2018. Following both of these requirements, districts will complete and submit to the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) the annual Elementary and Secondary Schools Assurance Form by February 15, 2018.

The Dayton School District reports that at this time we are in compliance with all of the Division 22 rules expect two: #2223- Health and Safe Schools Plan & #2340 Media Programs. The Health and Safe Schools Plan rule is a new one that we will work to comply with as we complete our facilities assessment this spring 2018. We do not comply with the Media Programs requirement because we do not have a Library/Media Specialist on our staff. We will work to address both of these in the near future.
