The Shelley Sonderman Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in memory of Shelley Rae Sonderman. Shelley was an outgoing, active participant at Dayton Jr-Sr High School and was a friend to all with whom she came in contact. Shelley lost her life in an auto accident on February 12, 1985 on her way to school. The purpose of this fund is to assist qualifying individuals in acquiring additional education to enhance their abilities and participation in a chosen trade or profession.

Who is eligible to apply?

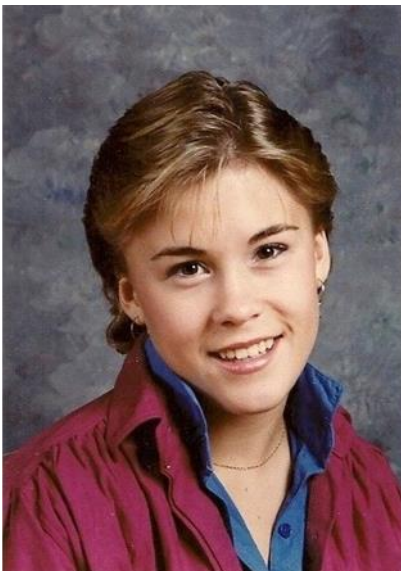
This scholarship is open to all Dayton High School graduating seniors with a desire to pursue additional college or vocational education/training. SAT scores and high school transcript are required. This scholarship is not based on financial need.

Criteria for Consideration

This application is our (Shelley's family members) opportunity to get to know you. Please use your answers to the questions and your essay to tell us about yourself. Proof-reading for accuracy, grammar, spelling, punctuation and content is critical.

How do I apply?

Complete the attached two-page application. Materials submitted will not be returned. Scholarship funds will be awarded equally by quarter or semester and must be used in the grant year designated. A student who is enrolled in school, stops attending, then re-enrolls will have this opportunity one time and still receive scholarship funds. Students must provide proof of registration to ABC-DEF in order for funds to be released to the college or vocational school of choice.

5. *Applications must be submitted to your school counselor **no later than Monday, April 17, 2017, 3:00 PM. (No exceptions).***
