## Application for Appointment to the Citizens Bond Oversight Committee

The Citizens Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC) is established as an advisory committee to the Superintendent and School Board. The Committee will work with our Bond Project Manager, Business Director, and Superintendent to oversee the expenditures of bond funds. The purpose of this committee is to represent taxpayers and to ensure accountability of bond funds. The Committee shall be composed of 5-8 at-large community members. The Committee will convene quarterly, or as needed, to review progress and to monitor spending and schedules on the projects detailed in the Dayton Bond Ballot Measure 36-201. The Committee will report quarterly to the Superintendent who will report to the School Board.

The Committee will have its initial meeting no later than September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2019 and will be dissolved upon issuance of a final report by the Committee after all projects authorized by the Dayton Bond Ballot Measure 36-201 have been completed. Meetings will be held at a time and location to be determined by the Citizens Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC). Applications are due no later than 4:00 p.m. on June 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

### Eligibility for the Citizen Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC):

1. Live within the Dayton School District boundary.
2. Be a registered voter.
3. Oversight Committee members may not be a School Board member, Budget Committee member, or an employee of the Dayton School District.
4. Owners and/or employees of bond project vendors and/or contractors may not serve on this committee.
